Use printmaking techniques to create bold and vibrant banners inspired by the Ukrainian artist Maria Prymachenko. Carry them in the parade created by arts organisation 6 Million+ on Saturday 15th of June.

We have 6 x 2hr sessions available on these dates: morning, afternoon or after-school /evenings Mon 8, Thurs 11, Fri 12, Mon 15, Thurs 18, Mon 22, Thurs 23, Fri 24, Mon 29, Wed 1, Thurs 2, Fri 3, Mon 6, Wed 8, Thurs 7, Fri 8, Mon 13, Wed 15, Thus 17, Tues 20, Thus 22 and Fri 24 May.

On Tuesdays 9, 16, 23, 30 April and 7, 14 May only daytime sessions are available (no evenings/after school). Sessions can be adapted the session to suit group needs.
