Good Lining Up

Good sitting on a chair

- Six legs
- Sit still
- Hands in laps or arms folded
- Keep hands and feet to yourself

Good listening

- Look at the speaker
- Think about what is said
- Be still and silent

Good partner and group work

- Classroom voice
- Take turns
- Good listening
