We hope you all had a lovely Easter holiday, enjoyed the break and are all eager and ready to tackle the last term and new topics with vim and vigour.

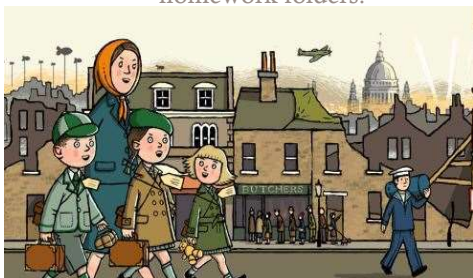
### Homework

### Road Safety

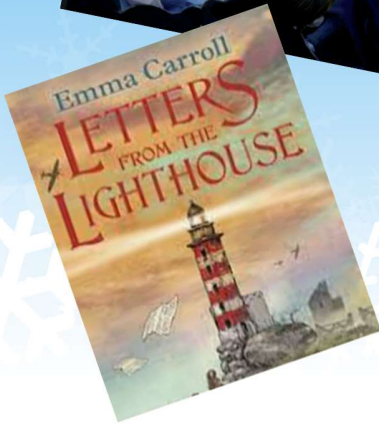
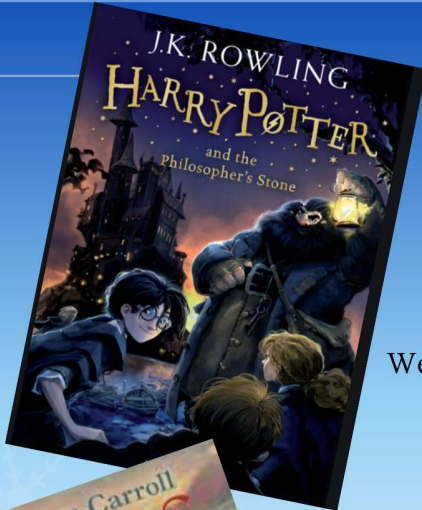
Road safety training is provided by Kirklees Road Safety Team. It will involve both classroom and practical roadside training. Children should wear normal school uniform.
